## What & How to Visualize Tsunami Damage in our drill

Pick your island and Look up your address at: <a href="https://tsunami.coast.noaa.gov/#/">https://tsunami.coast.noaa.gov/#/</a>
This is my approximate location. I could walk down the street to get close to the Extreme Tsunami Zone and visualize the damage: [arrow shows where I could stand]



Now I could establish the location [Lat / Long] and make up my own inject:

"Just South of Kalohelani PI. on Kealahou St. [21.2925, -157.6726] Water, sand, debris and cars are blocking Kealahou. Makai of that point, many homes in Queen's Gate and Laulima were totally destroyed by the wave. 10 - 12 people are injured ,wandering around, needing first aid. Unable to proceed past this area because of the damage."

Based on the visualization above I could submit a **Hawaii Damage Report**:

"This is an exercise message.

Just South of Kalohelani Pl. on Kealahou St. [21.2925, -157.6726]

Water, sand, debris and cars are blocking Kealahou. Makai of that point many homes in Queen's Gate and Laulima were totally destroyed by the wave.

This is an exercise message."

## And submit a **Hawaii Request for Assistance**:

"This is an exercise message.

Just South of Kalohelani Pl. on Kealahou St. [21.2925, -157.6726] 10 - 12 people are injured ,wandering around, needing first aid. Please send an ambulance ASAP. We will set up a Medical Treatment Area with CERT members until they arrive. This is an exercise message."
